## The Division of Family Medicine at Quinte Health Belleville General Hospital is seeking family medicine hospitalist physicians to join a great collegial and supportive team!

Responsibilities include: Inpatient care on our medicine, rehab, integrated stroke, and ALC units, and call.

Physicians benefit from 24-hour support from internal medicine, intensive care, general surgery, orthopaedics, urology, paediatrics, anesthesia, obstetrics and gynaecology, psychiatry, otolaryngology, and radiology. Diagnostic imaging on site includes Ultrasound, CT and MRI.

Considering our proximity to Kingston, and the Belleville-Quinte Family Medicine Program, many physicians are affiliated with Queen's University as Assistant Professors and regularly participate in resident training.

There may be opportunities for emergency medicine work. There are also opportunities in the area for clinic locums, OR assist, coroners work and more.

Opportunities exist to combine work with community practice in one of the local FHOs. The Belleville Family Physician Recruitment Program offers medical students up to \$150,000 in return for a five-year commitment of full-time service to a community practice and hospitalist work is encouraged.

Hospitalist work at BGH bills \$10,000-15,000/week (7 days, with 2-3 calls), which includes a stipend as well as all FFS billings.
