An opportunity for a part-time clinical neurologist exists at Belleville General Hospital.

Responsibilities include support in the Stroke Prevention Clinic, with 2-3 days per week plus a consultative role within the hospital and Stroke ward frequency as per agreement to be discussed.

Join the Department of Medicine, Division of Neurology at Quinte Health Belleville General Hospital, as an associate staff member. We are a busy, full service community hospital servicing the city of Belleville and region with a total population of approximately 160,000. Our Medicine program has 2 acute inpatient units, 1 stroke unit and 1 rehabilitation ward with average count of 170 acute medicine patients per day. Stroke patients are also supported through an integrated day hospital rehabilitation center.

You will join a department of both generalists and subspecialists including: Cardiology, Gastroenterology, Endocrinology, Nephrology, and Medical Oncology. We have a 18 bed ICU which also leads the code stroke, a Cancer Centre, a busy inpatient service with medicine patient covered by internal medicine and family medicine hospitalists, and excellent access to diagnostic imaging services, including CT and an MRI.

Belleville General Hospital is a clinical education campus of Queen's University. The successful applicant will be expected to contribute as a clinician-teacher at both the postgraduate level with learners participating in outpatient care.

Fellowship with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (or equivalent) and registration with (or eligibility for) the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario is required.

Established physicians and graduating residents are both encouraged to apply.

Quinte Health has 1,800 staff members and 320 medical staff who provide a wide range of high quality health care services to a region of 160,000 residents. Care is provided through four hospitals – Belleville General Hospital, North Hastings Hospital, Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital and Trenton Memorial Hospitals – and includes four emergency departments, operating rooms at three sites, inpatient services (including acute medicine, intensive care, obstetrics, paediatrics, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation and surgery), a rehabilitation day hospital, children's treatment centre, ambulatory care clinics, community mental health programs, and a range of diagnostic services.

The Quinte area is in south-eastern Ontario. Our hospitals are located in Belleville, Picton, Quinte West (includes Trenton and Brighton), and Bancroft. The area includes some of the most



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diverse and beautiful countryside in Ontario. From the lakes of Bancroft down to the wine country, picturesque towns, and Sandbanks beach of Prince Edward County, and through the more urban Belleville/Quinte West/Brighton corridor alongside Lake Ontario, almost every lifestyle interest can be found within the communities served by QHC. The region offers low cost of living, affordable homes, and excellent schools as well as quality local theatre, shopping and restaurants. Belleville and Quinte West are located along the highway 401 corridor, and Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal, and Kingston are all easy driving distance.
