Acute Care Psychiatric/Mental Health Services are provided at Quinte Health Belleville General Hospital as a Schedule One facility under the Mental Health Act. The mental health program includes inpatient, outpatient, transitional outpatient care, emergency services, consultations, and educational services to the community. In addition to the Schedule One services, our spectrum of care includes an Assertive Community Treatment Team, outpatient psychotherapy services and a Crisis Centre. Our Psychiatry team provides 24-hour call coverage.

Quinte Health is seeking a psychiatrist who is prepared to work or cross-cover through the full range of our mental health services.
