

Medical Oncology, APP Position

The Dr. Douglas A. MacIntosh Cancer Clinic - Belleville General Hospital, in partnership with The Cancer Centre of Southeastern Ontario (CCSEO)/Queen's University is seeking a Medical Oncologist with interest in management of both malignant hematology and solid tumors

This 1.0 FTE position is fully funded by MOH as an ONT MOA APP position with competitive salary.

The successful applicant will have the unique opportunity of working in the cancer clinic of a community-based hospital in Belleville as well as at the CCSEO; a Queen's University based, academic, tertiary care Regional Cancer Centre in Kingston. Both facilities offer new state of the art clinics and are supported by a dedicated group of pharmacists, knowledgeable and oncology focused nursing staff and an exemplary administrative team.

This position includes a 0.9 FTE at The Dr. Douglas A. MacIntosh Cancer Clinic which is in the Belleville General Hospital. The successful applicant will join a team of 3 full-time and 1 part-time medical oncologists. As a Level 3 Cancer Centre full medical oncology management of almost all disease sites is offered locally along with several surgical oncology services. Additional surgical oncology as well as radiation oncology care is provided at the CCSEO.

As a member of the Internal Medicine team at BGH, candidates would be expected to participate in all academic and clinical work pertaining to this department, including shared call duties which include admissions and IM consultations.

This position includes a 0.1 FTE affiliation with the CCSEO / Queen's University where opportunities for clinical care, research and teaching can be pursued. The successful candidate will be eligible for an academic appointment at Queen's University at a rank commensurable with their qualifications.

Quinte Health is a four-site hospital corporation that provides primary and secondary services to a diverse catchment area of approximately 160,000 people in the Hasting, Prince Edward Counties, and the Southeast portion of Northumberland County.

The Belleville General Hospital is situated on the shore of the Bay of Quinte.
