

****Siblings under the age of 16 are permitted, no other visitors under the age of 16****

Paediatrics:

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) 24/7

Additional visitors permitted between the hours of 0800-2000, no more than 3 at the bedside at any given time (this includes the parent(s)/guardian(s)).

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU):

Care partners in the NICU will be identified by the parent(s)/guardian(s) to a maximum of 6 people and will include the parent(s)/guardian(s). Siblings under 16 will be permitted to visit between 0800-2000 provided they are able to adhere to hospital masking requirements.

Any visitor to the NICU who is unwell is not permitted and should contact the care team for more information.

Limitations on the number of care partners in the NICU at one time will be based on NICU census:

Number of newborns in NICU	Number of care partners at bedside at one time
1-4	2
5-7	1
8 or more	1



When the census in the NICU is 5-7:

2 care partners may be at the bedside at one time as long as there are no more than 7 care partners in the NICU in total and physical distancing can be maintained

Obstetrical Assessment Unit:

1 consistent care partner is permitted in the assessment unit for all visits

Labour & Delivery (L&D):

Maximum 3 consistent care partners during L&D

For patients undergoing Caesarean Section – 1 care partner for the admission process (for scheduled patients), during surgery and in the recovery room. *Please ask your additional care partners to wait at home until you can let them know you have been moved to Postpartum.

Postpartum/Antepartum:

One consistent care partner permitted 24/7

Additional visitors permitted between the hours of 0800-2000, no more than 3 at the bedside at any given time (this includes the care partner)

For all visitors to our program – If you have a need for an exception, please discuss this with your care team
